



Hearing / Vision Screening

The DCFS licensing standard requires all children ages 3-6 year olds that are not in public kindergarten to have yearly vision and hearing screening.

On Friday, November 17th will be a vision and hearing screening. The testing is done by a professional trained to administer vision and hearing screening in the state of Illinois.

Please fill out the attached form and return it back to school by November 17th.

After screening is complete, results will be sent home, with follow up information if necessary.

It is important to note that a vision and hearing screening is not a substitute for a complete eye and vision evaluation by an eye or audio doctor

Your child is not required to undergo this vision screening if an optometrist or ophthalmologist has completed and signed a state form indicating that an examination has been administered within previous 12 months. So, children who wear glasses and/or under the care of a vision doctor do not receive a vision screening. Also, your child is not required to undergo hearing screening if an audiological evaluation completed by an audiologist within the previous 12 months is provided to the center.

If your child misses the screening date, arrangements will need to be made to see an ophthalmologist and an audiologist.
